

Das **LESEHAUS**

1. AIM OF THE CAMPAIGN:

With the Lesehaus campaign, we want to encourage a love of reading and motivate children to read regularly. Reading for about 10 minutes every day helps strengthen reading skills and thereby increases enjoyment of reading. The children receive various prizes for their reading achievements.

2. HOW THE LESEHAUS WORKS:

During the campaign period, the children should read aloud for about 10 minutes every day whenever possible.

- ✓ After the child has read aloud, an adult enters the date, the title of the text read and their signature in one window of the Lesehaus.
 - ✓ A maximum of one window may be completed per day.
 - ✓ When a Lesehaus has been completely filled in, it is handed to the class teacher and exchanged for a new sheet.
- ✗ Silent reading and adults reading aloud to the children do not count.

3. READING TARGETS:

To take part in the surprise trip, the following reading targets must be reached:

- Grade 1: 2 complete Lesehaus sheets (16 windows each)
- Grade 2: 3 complete Lesehaus sheets (16 windows each)
- Grade 3: 4 complete Lesehaus sheets (20 windows each)
- Grade 4: 5 complete Lesehaus sheets (20 windows each)

4. PRIZES:

 Surprise trip for all children who reach their reading target.

 Book voucher and certificate for all children with the highest number of completely filled Lesehaus sheets in their year group. [Maximum number of Lesehaus sheets per child: Grades 1 and 2: 15; Grades 3 and 4: 12]

 Surprise for the class with the highest average reading achievement. For this purpose, the total number of completed Lesehaus windows in a class is divided by the number of children in that class.

➔ The prizes will be presented to the children in a ceremony at the end of the school year.
